TO: ALL TEA AND COFFEE SUBSECTOR EMPLOYERS AND EMPLOYEES IN THE AGRICULTURAL INDUSTRY IN ZIMBABWE.

RE: TEA AND COFFEE SUB-SECTOR MINIMUM WAGES SCHEDULE AND ALLOWANCES FOR SEPTEMBER 2025

We refer to the Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA) of 1st June 2025.

The minimum wage for the Tea and Coffee subsector shall be payable in a component of 70% United States Dollars (USD) and a USD component of 30% convertible to the Zimbabwe Gold (ZWG) currency according to the prevailing interbank rate on the date of payment. Entities with capacity can pay 100% of the wage in United States dollars.
